

Author checklist

Please study this checklist and modify the manuscript appropriately. Failure to do so will delay the review process and the article will **NOT** move to the next step.

Your paper must have a significant focus on **PROCESSING** and cannot be mere modeling or properties as it will be rejected.

1. Please make sure that your paper is arranged with the following section headings - abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusions and then references followed by Figures and Tables. This is **MANDATORY** and **NO other subheadings** will be accepted.
2. You should clearly state within the introduction the **novelty of the work**, how it differs from previous published efforts, and how it will add to the body of new literature.
3. **Mechanisms** must be clearly stated for the phenomena observed in the discussion section and must not be empirical.
4. Conclusions must be comprehensive and should clearly indicate the industrial value/relevance for the approaches described in your paper.
5. Titles **must not exceed 10 words**. The title, abstract and keywords should include the key concepts likely to be used as search terms
6. Your paper **must not exceed 20** typed pages including figures
7. Please use **arrows or circles** to draw attention to specific figure features as necessary.
8. Unless you wish to pay for colour publication, all colour images will be reproduced in black and white in the print version and so you must upload both a black and white version for print publication and a colour version for online publication.
9. All drawings must be B and W only and should use **dots or dashes** for different lines.
10. Figures should be submitted in high resolution and cannot be in color as it does not print.
11. All lettering must be **11 pt times roman or higher** for easy reading.
12. Please ensure that all references are formatted according to [guidelines](#). They **MUST be in the format `https://www.tandf.co.uk//journals/authors/style/reference/tf_USACS.pdf`**
13. You must ensure that all relevant publications are appropriately cited. The journal encourages authors to search a variety of databases to make sure that all past work that is relevant to the study is properly referred. Databases for your consideration include; **Web of Science, Scopus, Ulrich's, EBSCO, Inspec, Proquest, Google Scholar**
14. To maintain a current list of reviewers for MAMP please submit a list of 5 active researchers in the field, along with email addresses and affiliation. Please do not suggest friends or colleagues and note that these researchers will not necessarily be invited to review your manuscript. Please email your list to sudarshan@matmod.com.
